



FYNBOS TRAIL RATE SHEET

1 March 2018 to 1 March 2019

Total hiking distance for standard trail is 25 km

Day 1 is a three hour walk that covers 6.6 kilometres from Steynsbos to Fynbos Retreat.

Day 2 is an 11 km walk that takes most of the day and takes hikers from the first overnight at Fynbos Retreat to the second overnight at Witkrans.

Day 3 is a 7.8 km walk that takes about four hours from Witkrans to the finish at Grootbos Garden Lodge.

OPTION 1 – Full slack packing option

Includes: Overnight accommodation at fully equipped Fynbos Retreat and Witkrans, two dinners, two lunches and two breakfasts (final lunch at five star Grootbos Nature Reserve Garden Lodge), Lomond wine tasting at Fynbos Retreat or Witkrans, one round of drinks with dinner (extra drinks either bring along or cash bar facilities), expert guide for three days, signed Field guide to the flora of Grootbos Nature Reserve and the Walker Bay region, planting of indigenous tree at Stinkhoutsbos Forest on day two lunch stop, fynbos gift on completion of trail, all luggage transfers and transfer after lunch on day 3 back to cars at the start.

Note: Minimum group size of 4 required for this option.

Price: R3475 per person over weekend (or including Friday and Saturday nights)

Price: R3275 per person during the week (Sunday to Thursday night)

Surcharge if less than 4 people: R600/person (no less than 2 people)

OPTION 2 – Self guided slack packing option

Includes : Overnight accommodation at fully equipped Fynbos Retreat and Witkrans, two dinners, two lunches and two breakfasts (final lunch at five star Grootbos Nature Reserve Garden Lodge), (drinks excluded but you are welcome to bring along drinks and they will be transported to overnight stops and chilled for your arrival), all luggage transfers and transfer after lunch on day 3 back to cars at the start.

Price: R2850 per person over weekend (or including Friday and Saturday nights)

Price: R2650 per person during the week (Sunday to Thursday night)

Surcharge if less than 4 people: R300/person (no less than 2 people)

OPTION 3 – Self guided and self catered

Includes: Overnight accommodation at fully equipped Fynbos Retreat and Witkrans, route map and narrative. Please note this is a circular route that takes hikers all the way back to the start at Steynsbos.

Price: R1050 per person

Optional Extra: Portage R200 per person



COASTAL ADD-ON RATES

1 March 2018 to 1 March 2019

Total hiking distance for the coastal section is 9km and takes about 4 hours.

It is recommended that this part of the route is done at the start of the trail.

Hikers will arrive at their guest house, from where they will be transferred to the Drup Kelders, where they'll get a guided tour of these amazing caves, followed by a walk back to the accommodation. * The following day the route takes hikers along the Klipgat Trail on the De Kelders coastline overlooking Walker Bay. The rocky cliffs at De Kelders are amongst the very best places in the World to view magnificent Southern Right Whales (June to December). The route includes Die Plaat and Duiwelsgat and Klipgat caves. The trail will then link up to the start of the Fynbos Trail.

Price:

Full slack packing – R1650 (includes overnight accommodation in De Kelders, dinner, breakfast, morning tea, lunch, Permit fees for Walker Bay Nature Reserves, transfer to Growing the Future, luggage transfers and guide)

*NB: This section can not be done without a guide as it is very difficult to find your way through the unmarked dune fields.
